


Setting up the new Hewlett-Packard LaserJet 1320 Printer

Step 1

Download and unpack the driver from Hewlett-Packard:

1. In your web browser, enter the following url: 
<ftp.hp.com/pub/softlib/software4/COL9747/lj-27308-1/lj1320PCL6win2kxp2003-en.exe>
2. Save the file to your disk in some place where you can find it (e.g., your desktop).
3. Run the file '*lj1320PCL6win2kxp-en.exe*' from that location to begin the printer driver installation.
4. Accept the license agreement, click 'Next.'
5. Click 'next' again to save in "C:\Program Files\Hewlett-Packard\LaserJet 1320 Drivers"
6. Click 'Finish.'

Step 2

Begin printer setup

1. Bring up your start menu, and select 'Printers and Faxes' from the menu.
2. Double-Click the 'Add Printer' icon.
3. Click 'Next' to begin.
4. Select 'Local printer attached to this computer.'
(I'm serious—don't ask me why Microsoft did it this way.)
5. Click 'Next.'
6. Select 'Create a new port' and choose the 'Type of port' to be 'Standard TCP/IP Port.'
7. Click 'Next.'

Step 3

Add a TCP/IP printer port

1. A new window (the Add Standard TCP/IP Printer Port Wizard) pops up.
2. Click 'Next.'
3. Enter the following information for the 'Printer Name or IP Address' field:
ZhouPrint2.recc.ou.edu
(The second field is filled out automatically for you. This is fine.)
4. Click 'Next,' and then click 'Finish.'
5. Now you will need to tell windows where to find the driver.
6. Click 'Have Disk...'
7. Click 'Browse...' and locate the folder:
"C:\Program Files\Hewlett-Packard\Laserjet 1320 Drivers" (and click 'Open') or simply enter that folder name in the input field.
8. Click 'OK.'

Step 4

Customize generic driver options

1. Now select the type of printer: 'HP LaserJet 1320 PCL 6.'
2. Click 'Next.'
3. Give the printer a name (e.g., "HP 1320").
4. If you like, select the printer as the default printer.
5. Click 'Next.'
6. Make sure 'Do not share this printer' is selected, then click 'Next.'
7. Click 'Next' again, and a test page should print after installation.
8. Click 'Finish.' Windows will now copy the driver files to system locations, and print a test page. Click 'OK' to confirm the printing of the test page.
9. Close the 'Printers and Faxes' window. That's it!
